Where are Your Classmates?

- The Salem High School Alumni Association office can print a list of your classmates. We can also provide address labels for the classmates in our database.

Schedule Your Meeting

- The alumni office is available for class meetings, early evening or during the day, including weekends. You will need to call at least two weeks prior to book the room. Please contact SHSAA: 330-332-1427, or info@salemohioalumni.org.

- Create a Facebook page for your event. Please notify the SHSAA office of your page, and we will link your Facebook page to our website.

At Your First Meeting

- Elect or appoint a previous or new class coordinator and assistant.
 - This may or may not always be the class president or class officers.
 - Those who live in or around Salem tend to be a good choice as they can visit venues, SHSAA office, and any other places, as necessary.
 - The class coordinator is the contact person for all class matters over the years. Please inform the SHSAA who the class coordinator is for your class. Some classes have more than one coordinator and that is acceptable, as well.
- Discuss possible dates and locations for your reunion
- Take into consideration...Cost of facility rental, meal cost, bar/bartender cost, sales tax, tip, music, favors, etc.

Immediately After Your First Meeting: Set your Date and Venue

- Contact SHSAA and we will publicize the event on our website, social media, and in the newsletter.
- Consider mailing "Save the Date" postcards to your classmates.

December 1: Deadline for Honored Alumnus Nominations

- The honored alumnus is an award given in May at the scholarship ceremony. It honors an SHS graduate for his or her outstanding contributions in the community and for professional excellence. If your class wishes to nominate an individual, those applications can be completed online.

November-January

- Secure a live band or DJ.
- Select program details, and plan decorations and possible favors.
- Select a master of ceremonies, if needed, to host and organize the program.

January-February

- Send a mailing to all class members with details of your reunion.
- Use social media to promote your event(s).
- Bulk mail services are available through the SHSAA. Please... Just ask us!

In the Spring

- Continue class meetings, if needed.
- Continue to make decisions for food, decorations, RSVPs, parking, etc.
 - Don't forget to delegate!
- Fundraising for a class gift toward the SHSAA Scholarship Fund is appreciated.
- Consider inviting Executive Director Audrey Null to part of your reunion.
- Keep in touch with the alumni association office!

SHSAA Bulk Mail Guide:

- Using USPS bulk mail means that you can send out a large mailing at a discounted rate. This service is limited to permit holders, but as a Salem High School class, you are welcome to use the SHSAA permit.

(A bulk mailing must meet certain requirements. We can assist with this process. Please call the SHSAA office and ask for Denise at 330-332-1427 for instructions.)

SHSAA Office Assistance:

- The office will provide some copying for classes. Address and return labels, etc. will also be given upon request. Every class mailing is different, so please ask for information.

Banking & Accounting:

- Open a reunion bank account with joint authorization for 2 committee members (Chairman and Treasurer).
- Make copies of checks received before depositing them and all checks written.
- Detail incoming and outgoing money in a ledger or electronic document.
- Ensure that you can cover costs.
- Reunion committee members should consider putting in a starting amount of money to be applied to all upfront costs. Credit to committee members can then be given later when reservations are taken for the reunion events.

Donations to SHSAA are Appreciated.

- Many classes generously contribute to the SHSAA Scholarship Fund. You, too, may want to plan a class gift.
- Along with wanting to support our scholarships, many classes offer donations to the SHSAA as a token of thanks for the reunion planning services provided.
- ***If you wish to encourage donations to the SHSAA, below is a paragraph that you can include in your early communications to classmates.***
- Checks may be written to the SHSAA or to the Class. The Class can then provide one check as a class gift to the SHSAA. Donations made to SHSAA are tax deductible. Donations made to a class are not tax deductible.
- Don't forget to write a thank you note or send a receipt to all contributors.

“Your reunion committee has been meeting at the SHSAA office. We have been furnished with address labels, envelopes, class mailing lists, copying privileges, and a bulk mail permit as well as a very comfortable and pleasant place to meet. We would like to show our appreciation by presenting the association with a check on the night of our reunion. If you would like to contribute, you may send a check made out to the Salem High School Alumni Association at 330 E. State St., Salem, OH 44460 with a note that your donation will be a part of a class gift. It may be made in memory or honor of a loved one.

You can also make a check out to the class with similar notations. You will receive a thank you note as receipt of your donation. Donations made to the SHSAA are tax deductible, while donations made to the class are not. Either way, your gift will contribute to the SHSAA's work of awarding scholarships to deserving graduates.”
